As part of these duties, the Dean will be responsible for the following activities:

- Promote the professional development of the academic teams; manage the academic recruitment policy and processes,

- In collaboration with the Director of Programmes, guarantee the relevance of the curriculum, its direct link with the research activities and expertise of the School, as well as its compliance with the needs of the job market. Along with the Director of Programmes, the Dean also oversees the coherence of the overall programme portfolio.

## 4. Develop a culture of innovation and collaboration within the Faculty.

- Develop projects that encourage members of Faculty to collaborate effectively in the realization of the institutional strategy,
- Embrace, share and spread a culture of innovation and achievement to the benefit of stakeholders,
- Build any bridges and relationships with companies, institutions and authorities that create an environment for the successful development of Kedge's academic initiatives.

#### 5. Contribute to the internationalisation of the Group.

- Set up or strengthen processes to reinforce the international dimension of the Faculty,
- Take part in plans and projects for the development of on-line courses contributing to the renown and appeal of the Kedge brand internationally,
